CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

**3. ACCEPTANCE OF BID FOR ROAD CONSTRUCTION ON S.E. 3<sup>RD</sup> AVENUE**

The following bids were submitted: Knife River \$124,590.

Councilor Muenchrath made a motion to accept all bids as presented for the S.E. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Project. Councilor Capehart seconded the motion; all voted in favor.

**4. AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR ROAD CONSTRUCTION ON S.E. 3<sup>RD</sup> AVENUE**

Public Works Director Higgins said that everyone seems to busy and does not know why more companies did not bid on the project, the bid that was received did come in under the engineers estimate of \$132,275. The project includes the grinding and overly of 1,000 feet of S.E. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue as well as the conversion of about 300 feet of the gravel portion of SE 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave to asphalt road. The intersections at S. Henry Street and S.E. 3<sup>rd</sup> will also be improved.

Councilor Short made a motion to award the contract for the 1<sup>st</sup> S.E. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Project o Knife River for \$124,950. Councilor Wiese seconded the motion; all voted in favor.

City Manager O'Connor hopes the project will start the third week in September. Planner Higgins said that Knife River has elected to pave at night for the project on Central so they did not have to fight traffic.
